Jeremy Wing - 2nd!

A total of 256 players entered the \$400 No-Limit Hold'em event in the 2010 Foxwoods Poker Classic with a total prize pool of \$86,911 on the line, **Victor Chu** started the final table in the fourth position and grinded it out to secure the victory. The final table took almost three hours to reach five players and to end play at 2am early Wednesday morning. Play resumed later at noon and in 45 minutes the final two were determined and an agreement was reached leaving **Jeremy Wing** of Randolph, MA with \$15,000 for 2nd and Victor claiming the Commemorative Leather Jacket, the Championship Trophy and First Place Prize Money of \$19,808 to take back to Medford, MA!

The final table got underway after 11pm and it took almost an hour before **Robert Cooperstein** of Brookline, MA raised all-in with pocket 7's and was called by Jim Procaccini with AdJd. The flop (Jc10d4d) gave Jim Jacks and with 4c9s to complete the board, Robert was relegated to 10th earning \$1,434 for his efforts. Shortly thereafter, **Marc Leblanc** would move all-in with his last 28k from the big blind position, with 8h4c. He was called by Roger Fisette with pocket A's. The board came out Kd3s2h9hQh, leaving Marc in 9th place, taking \$1,836 back home to Gardiner, MA. A couple of hands later, **Jim Procaccini** moved all-in with AcKs, and was called by Ron Lapido, who had AsJs. Ron hit a jack on the flop (AdJh9c). The 2s8c completed the board and left Jim heading back to Trumbull, CT with 8th place money of \$2,694. **Thomas Hoglund** came to the final table severely short stacked, and survived a couple of all-in scenarios, but when he pushed his last 38k with AsJd, he couldn't survive the pair of 9's Roger (Ad9d) picked up on the turn. The board (Kh5d3s9hQh) couldn't rescue Tom this time, leaving him with a hard fought 7th place finish and a \$3,563 payday. The next eliminating hand saw **Sid Pike** of Lynnfield, MA raise all-in with 42k before the flop and was called by Ron. After the flop (Qs8s5s) gave Ron a pair all Sid could do was sweat out the the turn (8d) and river (2h) and in disappointment settle for \$5,475 for his 6th place finish.

The final five played for twenty minutes and decided to call it a night and return to play at noon. When play resumed just after noon, it took just 15 minutes for the field to go from five down to the final two. First to go was **Ron Lapido** of Canton, MA. Ron who was in for 70k before the flop would battle Jeremy Wing. After the Qs7h2c on the flop, Jeremy bet 30k and was raised all-in for 84k. Jeremy quickly called and showed pocket Q's to Ron who had QhJh. The 5h on the turn gave Ron some hope but the 5s on the river left Ron in 5th place with \$5,475 to show for his efforts. Next to leave was **Ed Leach** who would re-raise all-in with Ac9s. Victor called and turned over AsQs. The board of Qh8s6sJc3d gave Victor Q's with a flush draw and the Jc3d to complete the board, left Ed to settle for 4th, and \$6,432 to take back home to Georgetown, MA. The last player to leave would be **Roger Fisette** of North Providence, RI. Roger was heads-up with Victor and the board played Ac9h7d10s5d. Victor bet 140k only to be raised all-in by Roger. Victor snap called and showed 8s6d for the straight. Roger mucked and claimed \$7,387 for his 3rd place finish.

Victor Chu of Medford, MA had a 3 to 1 chip advantage over **Jeremy Wing** of Randolph, MA. The two finalists had a short discussion resulting in an agreement that left Jeremy with \$15,000 for 2nd while Victor would capture the Championship Trophy, Commemorative Leather Jacket, and \$19,808 to become the 2010 Foxwoods Poker Classic \$400 No-Limit Champion.

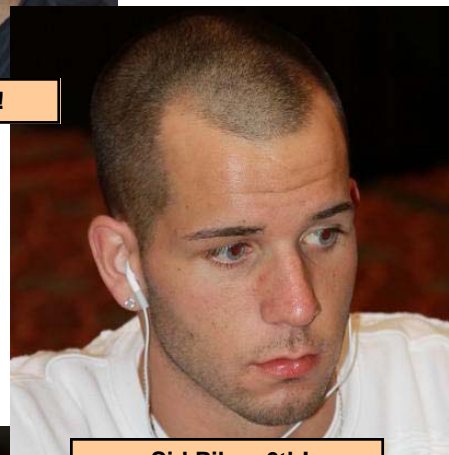

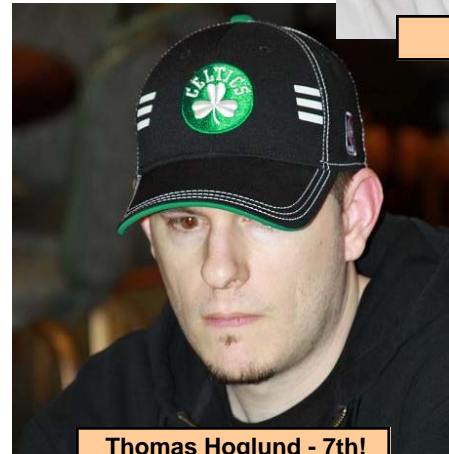

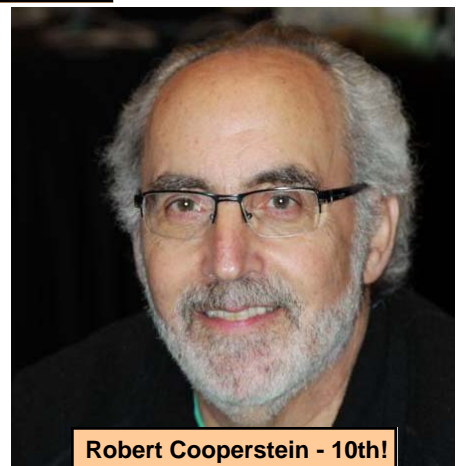
