The 2011 Foxwoods Poker Classic \$2,500 No-Limit Hold'em Championship attracted 284 entrants who competed for a total prize pool of \$640,490. In the end the final three reached an agreement leaving **Michael Lavoie** of Wolcott, CT, in 3rd with \$79,967, **Ron Pease** of Glastonbury, CT took \$108,295 for 2nd, while **Phil Reed** of Washington, DC captured the Commemorative Leather Jacket, the Championship Trophy and \$114,050 becoming the 2011 Foxwoods Poker Classic \$2,500 No-Limit Hold'em Champion.

On Sunday at Noon, seventeen contenders returned for the final days action. Play continued for two and a half hours before the final table was determined. Thirty minutes into final table action **Steve Ryan** of New York, NY found himself raising all-in with his last 240k. Ron called with pocket Queens to pocket Jacks for Steve. The As9s6c3s4s board left Steve in 10th earning \$12,169. On the next hand **Kyle Loman** lost the bulk of his chips and then found himself all-in on the following hand with Qd10d. He was called by Phil with pocket Queens. Once again the board (Jc4h4s6s7c) could not save the short stack as the Haverhill, MA resident finished 9th with a \$16,666 payday. **David Whalen** would raise 125k and was called by Todd Terry. After the 3c3d3h flop, both players checked. Dave moved all-in after the Jd fell on the river, and Todd quickly called. Dave turned over Kh10d, while Todd showed pocket Jacks leaving Dave with \$19,855 to take back to Whitman, MA for his 8th place finish. Play continued for half an hour before **Rodney Legendre** of Randolph, NH would raise to 100k. Phil re-raised to 290k and Rodney called. After the KhQd2h flop, Rodney pushed and Phil insta-called turning over pocket Kings for the set. Rodney turned over AhQh for the flush draw, but unfortunately the 3cJd to complete the board, ended Rodney's run with a 7th place and \$24,339. **Justin Schwartz**, who had lost most of his chips a couple of hands earlier would move all-in with his last 35k. Michael Lavoie called with pocket Jacks to Ad10h for Justin. The Kd9c5sQs2d board resigned Justin, a resident of Milford, CT, to 6th place and \$29,142. Two hands later **Darren Keyes** of Ontario, Canada raised all-in from the small with pocket 6's. Mike called from the big with AdJc. Mike picked up a straight draw on the 10h9h8h flop. The Ac on the turn gave Mike top pair and the Qd completed the straight, and relegated Darren to 5th place, earning \$35,868 for his efforts. **Todd Terry** called a raise to 90k by Ron. Phil also called, and the three watched the 9d7c2c come out on the flop. Ron bet 185k and was raised all-in by Todd. Phil folded, Ron called and turned over pocket 10's. Todd turned over AcJc for the nut flush draw, but the Kd10s on the turn and river resulted in a solid 4th place finish and \$46,755 in earnings for the Hoboken, NJ resident, Todd Terry.

The final three reached an agreement giving **Mike Lavoie** \$79,967 for 3rd, **Ron Pease** claimed \$108,295 for 2nd. **Phil Reed** secured \$114,050, the Jacket and Trophy becoming the 2011 Foxwoods Poker Classic \$2,500 No-Limit Hold'em Champion!
